We also held an 8-week engineering and electronics workshop with Collab Inc. for middle school girls from the Urban Assembly of Math and Science for Young Women.




After the earthquake in Haiti, we raised \$300 for Doctors Without Borders and mentored a FTC team with mostly Haitian members.
